


1: Title

Astrology Patterns with Tarot.

In this lecture, I will use my astrology chart to demonstrate how we can learn the patterns and symbols of astrology which represent the vibration we carry into incarnation and also how Tarot will assist with the necessary symbolism for our subconsciousness to respond more accurately with our life destiny and fate.











2: Astrology Patterns

With Astrology, we can discover patterns that reveal to us our pre-birth 'needs' and 'intentions' on what we desire to learn, experience and accomplish within our lifetime.

The difference between 'needs' and 'intent' can be discovered from the size of the houses by degrees on our astrology wheel along with the placement of the planets in the houses.

For example, a small house is considered less than 30 degrees in size which means within this lifetime, we established a pre-birth 'need' to fulfill a type of karmic balance, to grow the house in size by applying the attributions of that house to our everyday lives.

A large house is considered more than 30 degrees in size which means we do not need to focus as much on these houses in this life, because we have already experienced the qualities of the large houses in previous incarnations.

We can choose to use large house qualities that
we have already integrated into our
subconsciousness from previous incarnations
to help us with our difficult small house
'needs' that we aim to enhance in this lifetime.

In this incarnation, when we think 'needs', we can think of house size.

When we think of 'intentions', we can examine our planet locations.

This means that in our pre-birth 'intent',
we arranged the planetary imprint to an
exact degree in order to assist our individual
consciousness growth and with Humanity's
collective consciousness growth.

The Zodiac signs also include the attributions and energies that will determine how we accomplish our 'needs' and 'intentions'.

In summary, an easy way to remember the pre-birth placement of our incarnated imprint would be that houses represent our past, the Zodiac signs represent our present, and the Planets represent our future.

We can take Astrology patterns even further to pinpoint characteristics that our Personality and Individuality will desire to experience in this incarnation with Tarot and Qabalah.

Symbols are the Universal language for the subconsciousness, which Tarot provides for our self-consciousness to create the images within our mind that provides powerful suggestions which ultimately can create a type of marriage or union between both modes of consciousness.

This is why Tarot is so powerful.

When we hook Tarot into our incarnated astrological patterns, we can extend even further by referencing the Qabalah Tree of Life, and the 32 Paths of Wisdom which each contain their own Intelligences that flow through us and reflect off our Inner Planets (or Chakras).

To intertwine these spiritual modalities with the correct patterns of reference creates powerful symbols for our subconsciousness.

It is also important to know where our life-line is located on our astrology chart, meaning we can determine the phase of life we are experiencing by the current degree and our current physical age.

Finally, the transits will create a push and pull pattern sequence as they orbit around our pre-birth astrology imprint.

We can determine with the different astrological aspects such as oppositions and squares which present opportunities for our consciousness growth.

3: Pre-birth Needs

The Astrology wheel consist of 360 degrees which all twelve houses divide in range from small to large.

A house with 30 degrees is perfectly balanced, as seen in my 3rd and 9th house.

My 1st and 7th house are the smallest in my chart, which determines my greatest "need" in this incarnation.

This means that in previous incarnations,
I struggled with 1st and 7th house qualities.

Within this incarnation, I am to attempt the balancing of karmic energies or vibration to grow the size of my 1st and 7th house.

My largest house is the 5th and 11th house, which signifies that I accomplished a lot in previous incarnations within this area and I don't really need to focus too much on these houses within this incarnation.



This doesn't mean I completely ignore 5th and 11th house qualities because that is almost impossible as a human being, but I can be aware of the small and large houses to help me gauge my choices in life.

If I grow my smaller houses by choosing with my awareness to take action on this pre-birth 'need' already established, then this can decrease the size of my larger houses which will create a more balanced overall life.

4: 1st House: Aries

Each Astrological House can provide symbols and attributions to guide us on qualities that build our Personality or attributions that we can focus on in order to work with our subconsciousness to expand our awareness about ourself.

Let us begin with the 1st House, which belongs to the Zodiac sign, Aries.

This is the Self-definition House also known as, "I Am."

Attributions: Self-image. Self-confidence. Self-awareness.

Physical Body Development. Ego Development. Basic energy development. Instinct development.

16: Pre-birth Intentions

Let us remember that with our astrology chart, we can view:
the House size represents our past, the Zodiac sign represents our present,

With our pre-birth intentions, we create the blueprint of how we 'intend' to experience certain energies and frequencies in order to create karma and grow our individual consciousness along with collective consciousness.

and the Planets represent our future.

We can gather the associations of the position of an atom on a chromosomal strand in the DNA molecule from the House size, Planet position, and Zodiac sign.

The life-line represents the phases of life we journey through and is by degree in which we are always changing, transforming, dying, and becoming regenerated, renewed, and reborn.

The life-line position will be explained in depth later, but for now we need to understand the pre-birth intentions that we delegate to ourself before we incarnate and also why we assigned certain planet placements for creating life experiences.

Each Planet represents a genetic potential to accomplish something in a certain area of our life and also represents the possible different period of time in our life which these qualities are going to be more pronounced or influential.

The temperament of a Personality is established by using the four elements and the placement of the planets.

My chart has three Masculine placements which represent the Projective qualities and seven Feminine placements that represent the Receptive qualities.

This does not mean that there is more human female attributions or expressions that are exhibited through my Personality, but we can have an overall vantage point that I will seek a type of balance of the polarity of energies.

The planets and Zodiac sign will also provide symbolic expression of how the overall polarities will effect the molecular arrangement within me.

The overall goal of this knowing for my Personality's temperament is nothing more than a way for me to get organized in identifying myself to myself, not define myself.

We are multi-dimensional, Christ-consciousness beings, which we are changing in all moments, so let us remember that our astrology chart is not static, but provides a way for us to learn more about ourselves.

From one perspective of my astrology chart,
we can notice that my temperament will
default to a more grounding and emotional
receptive behavior pattern whereas the energy
for my physical and mental bodies,
the projective behavior pattern will be more
methodical, contemplative, maybe slower,
and most likely planned out before I take action.

The horizonal birth horizon provides another perspective where we can know how our temperament builds our overall physical, emotional, and mental bodies.

We can approximate that the lower half of our astrology chart is our inner world, the subjective aspect of ourself, and the top half is our outer world, the objective aspect of ourself.

As for my astrology chart, we can notice that my inner world is slightly more influential than my outer world based on the Planetary 'intents.'

To a degree, we can expect that my temperament will be more introverted than extroverted.

This means we can learn about ourselves
by knowing the outside world will have
projected frequencies from other energies
that provide reflections and consist
of attributions from the Zodiac signs
and Planets on the top half.

Our inner world works the same way,
but in a reverse manner, but we need
to know that our objective analysis and
subjective analysis of ourselves is
happening in all moments, simultaneously.

We need to know the importance of understanding that everything outside ourselves is a neutral state to a certain degree, meaning as we gather experiences in life, our subconscious mind is taking pictures of everything in all moments and we also need to know that our subconscious mind already knows everything.

There is nothing outside ourself that is forcing us to do anything or react a certain way, but our subjective and objective worlds are constantly colliding together and shaping our reality and the complexity grows from more than our astrology chart, but also from the influences of race-thought, conditioning of parental, family, and culture.

Let us remember that astrology only opens us up to possibilities of things occurring in a certain way at any point in time because we always have multiple choices of how we want to use our energies, our thoughts, our feelings/emotions, our activities, our imagination.

We have multiple choices and we try to pick what we consider to be the best choice, but this is not always true because we cannot see the larger picture in our life (or all of Life).

We do not always know what is best for ourselves, so we find out days/weeks/months from now that whatever happened was probably not the best choice, but we did learn something from our choice.

We learned not to choose "that previous choice" if it comes up again and so we move in another direction.

Ultimately, we cannot lose in the game of life.

Once we understand how things work, and know that everything is working to support us to move forward in life and move upward in life towards our spiritual consciousness, then we understand majority of the game of life.

Astrological work is manifesting from psychological, not physical.

The pre-birth destiny is another perspective where we can know how our temperament builds our overall physical, emotional, and mental bodies based primarily on pre-birth intent and planet placement.

We can use our Midheaven to determine not only our career or life path, but also to determine if we have incarnated for creating destiny or fulfilling destiny.

To "create destiny" is counterclockwise from the

10th House to the 3rd House which attributes
a more self-directed, self-motivated,
self-sustaining, independent journey.

To "fulfill destiny" is counterclockwise from the 3rd House to the 10th House which attributes to a stronger intent to become more cooperative, to work with others more harmoniously, to share with others, to try and accomplish group goals.

With my astrology chart, I have three planets on the left side and seven planets on the right side, which means I will attempt to focus more on being of service-to-others in order to grow my individual consciousness along with assisting collective consciousness from my family to the community and even the world.

This is not explicit because we all are service to our individual and collective consciousness, but with the pre-birth destiny perspective, we can have a better understanding of why we make certain choices or develop certain behaviors about ourself and others.

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For example, my Sun placement is Aquarius in my 7th House of relationships, which typically means that I will find it easy to share among others, or I will take notice more easily of how I can be of service to others.

I clearly see this behavior mindset and created patterns in my 44 years of life experience, whereas I also see other patterns that I created that where more self-serving but were very difficult for me to create and this is primarily because of my pre-birth intent of the destiny which I chose to bring into this incarnation.

19: Whole Life

The last perspective to present for the creation of our temperament and Personality is the "whole life" perspective of our astrology chart.

With the "whole life" perspective, we can divide the chart into four quadrants and then have an overview of attributions that hold more or less influence on how we plan to live our life.

The bottom half of the chart consist on the 1st and 2nd quadrant and primarily builds the "personal" and "family" aspects of our consciousness.

The top half of the chart is our "social" and "career" aspects, which also can be perceived as our outward life journey, whereas the bottom half is our inward life journey.

The bottom half can be considered the first half of our life and the top half will be the second half of our life.

This is only a symbolic perspective to guide us for the understanding of what we should focus on for our consciousness growth in our incarnated life.

I have six planets on the bottom half of my chart and four planets on the top half, which means
I will have slightly more of an introspective life, but also will focus on the to a lesser degree.

The math is nothing more than 60% of my energy will be used on my inward journeys and then 40% of what I learn about myself will be used on my outward journeys.

The advantage of using these four perspectives of our astrology chart helps us try to clearly see how we want to focus on what we would call our life purpose.

If we reference the attributions of the Houses,
Zodiac signs, and Planets, based on their
placement in each quadrant, then we can build
within our consciousness a blueprint of how we
created a pre-birth desire to create karma for life
experiences and consciousness growth.

In the next video, we will continue to analyze the astrology chart and how we can use Tarot, Qabalah, and the tools of Astrology in order to create a better understanding of our vibration that we carry in this lifetime.

Our vibration is not static which constantly changes with how we implement frequency management, which means how we project and receive frequencies in order to transmute and alchemize our human experiences.

We are all Christ Consciousness Beings and can manifest through the laws of this reality with our creative imagination in such a big way that the Universe can create new circumstances for us to move into those bigger experiences.

If we put limitations on ourself due to past thoughts, past situations, past beliefs, then we are not aware of the potentialities and capabilities that we can choose which ultimately could expand our consciousness and also assist Humanity with consciousness growth.

We need to know that eventually in this life or another incarnation that we will decide that the limitations and restrictions that we have structured from our past do not govern what is going to happen in our future, meaning we can "let them go."

We are very powerful, but are being grown from a Higher Intelligence, which really is all of us in a Higher Collective Consciousness, so we need to know that we govern what will happen to our future, and we do not need to repeat the future from the past.

Most of us get lazy and let the past continue to happen again and again, which creates habits that make us comfortable and what appears safe, but eventually we arrive in our consciousness growth that our creative imagination will guide us intuitively and we willfully change our direction to another and more supportive growing consciousness path.

The way we think is projected as thoughts into the Universe and creates realities that we want to experience, not only in this incarnated life, but in multiple incarnations simultaneously because we are Multi-dimensional Beings.

In conclusion, the next video will demonstrate how we can explore the four quadrants and determine how we can create fragments of our life so that we can examine future potentialities but also review our life experiences which shapes our current point in our life phases as we journey through life for our consciousness growth.
