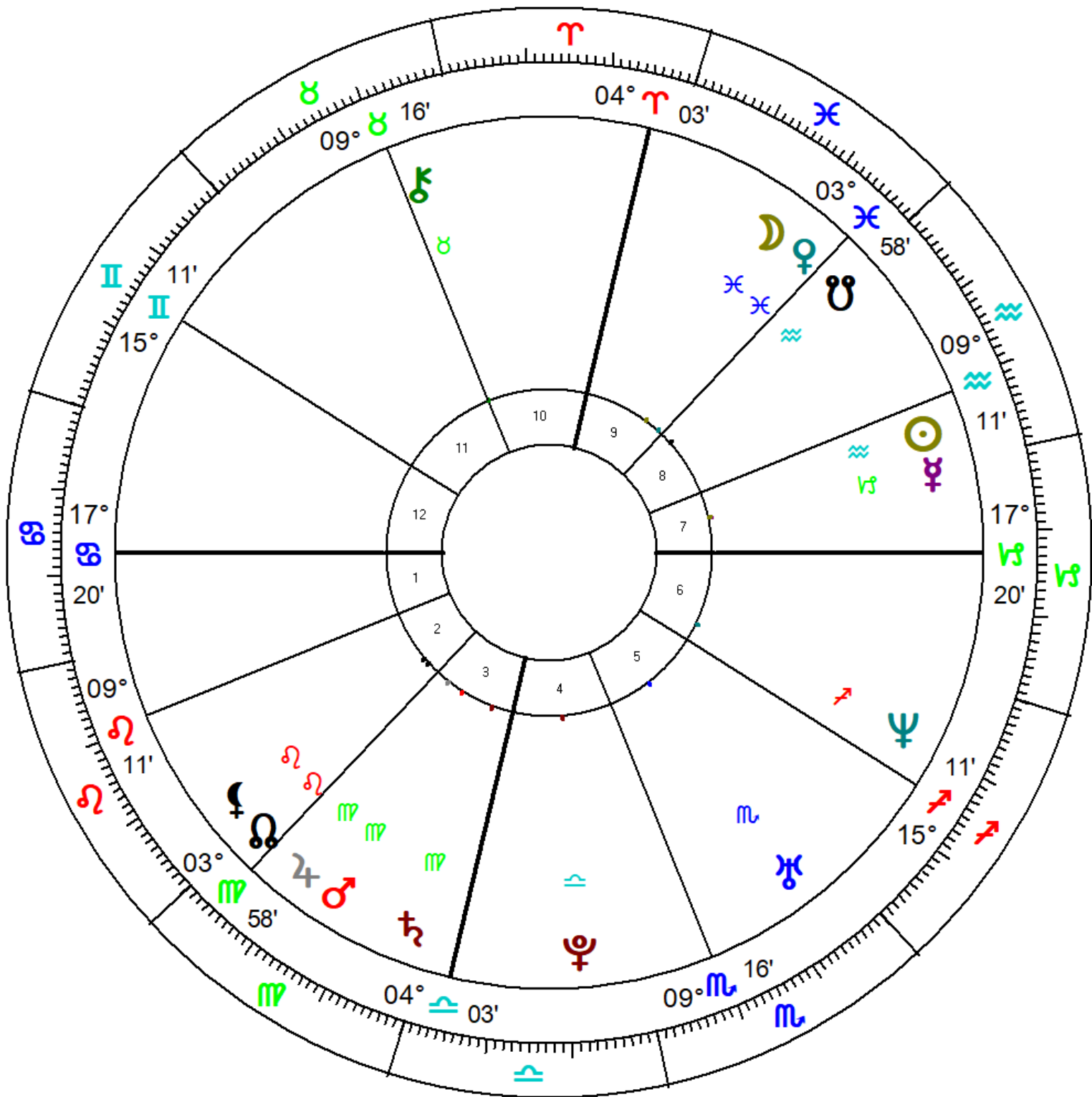
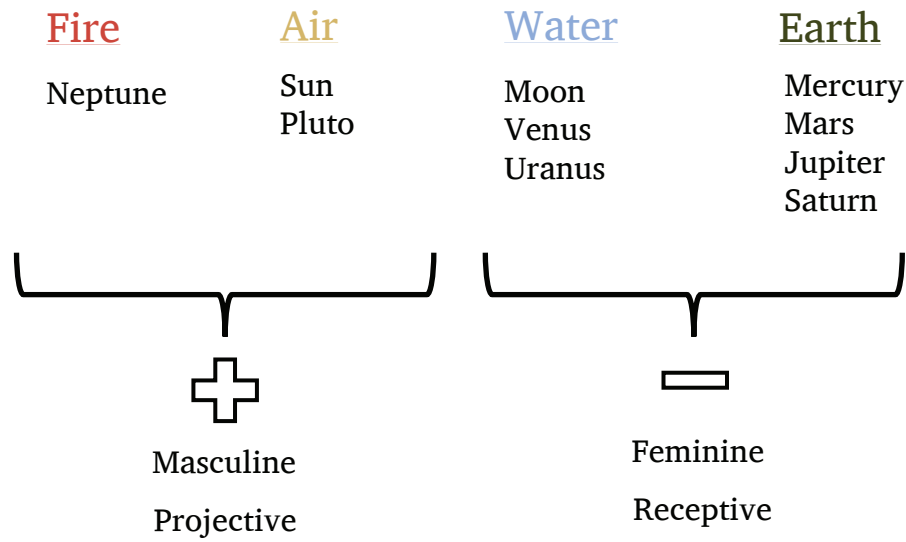

 1: Title

Astrology Patterns with Tarot.

In this lecture, I will continue to use my Astrology chart to demonstrate how we can learn the patterns and symbols of Astrology with Tarot to assist with our subconscious response for a more accurate overview with our life destiny.

The previous lecture, I primarily focused on how we can determine our life-line in our astrology chart while also we can determine the life phases that we ascend into and descend out of along with the ability to acknowledge our pre-birth 'intents' and our pre-birth 'needs' for this lifetime.

2: Quadrant Rulers

We have identified and established the rulers of each quadrant on the Personality layer of my astrology chart.

As a review from the previous lecture, we need to identify the quadrant rulers on the Personality layer because we can extract the symbols from the four quadrants that will allow us to focus on how to penetrate to the Foundation layer.

3: Quadrant Rulers

We all have the same Foundation layer already established within us, but in order to individuate and appear separate, we incarnate at different degrees for our initial position at birth in order to rearrange our atomic structure on our chromosomal strand within our DNA molecules.

This creates the Personality layer and is what changes the characteristics of us as individuals which has to do with the distance between the atoms on our chromosomal strand.

Each quadrant represents a different genetic potential and also represents the possible different phase in our life which these qualities will be more pronounced than in other areas or phases within our life.

4: 1st Quadrant: 1st House

Now we will isolate the 1st Quadrant and move my life-line though the 1st House, 2nd House, and 3rd House.

In order for me to have a good understanding of the Temperament which my Personality will use in this life, I create fragments with symbols, numbers, and attributions within each House of the 4 Quadrants.

Our Temperament is determined by the 4 elements of Earth, Water, Air, Fire, which include the Masculine and Feminine principle that is within the elements.

Let us remember that each of the 4 Quadrants have a ruler which is determined by the ascendent of that particular Quadrant.

From my birth to approximately the age of 6.25 years old, my life-line determines that my Personality has been colored with the development of 1st House qualities with the Zodiac sign Cancer, which is also assigned to Key 7 in Tarot.

Although my life-line enters Leo around the age of 3.5 years old, the 1st House is still ruled by Cancer.

Let's remember that the Zodiac signs represent the present moment at that particular phase in life, which means the Leo qualities will become more expressive from the age of 3.5 to 6.25 as my life-line exits the 1st House and enters the 2nd House.

On the Foundation layer, Aries rules the 1st House and 1st Quadrant which is the self-definition house of "I Am."

The 1st House builds our self-image, self-confidence, self-awareness, along with the development of a physical body for this life, and also the development of our basic energy which includes the building of our instinct and ego.

Cancer is a water sign that has qualities which represent sensitivity, kindness, patience, empathy, devotion and loyalty, but also has the defects of attachments, lack of self-confidence, melancholy, inconsistency, and to be naive.

One of the deepest 'needs' for my 1st House development is to have a harmonious home and family life in order to assist with the development from life experiences for the control of my emotional expressions.

With my small 1st House of 22 degrees, we know that I struggled in a previous incarnation with 1st House attributions such as self-image and self-confidence.

Within this lifetime, my Personality will be mostly identified as a type of introvert, which can be symbolic for the Cancer crab, but the importance is for me to develop Aries qualities through the Zodiac sign of Cancer.

We know that the ruling planet for Cancer is the Moon, which in my astrology chart is located in the 9th House of Pisces.

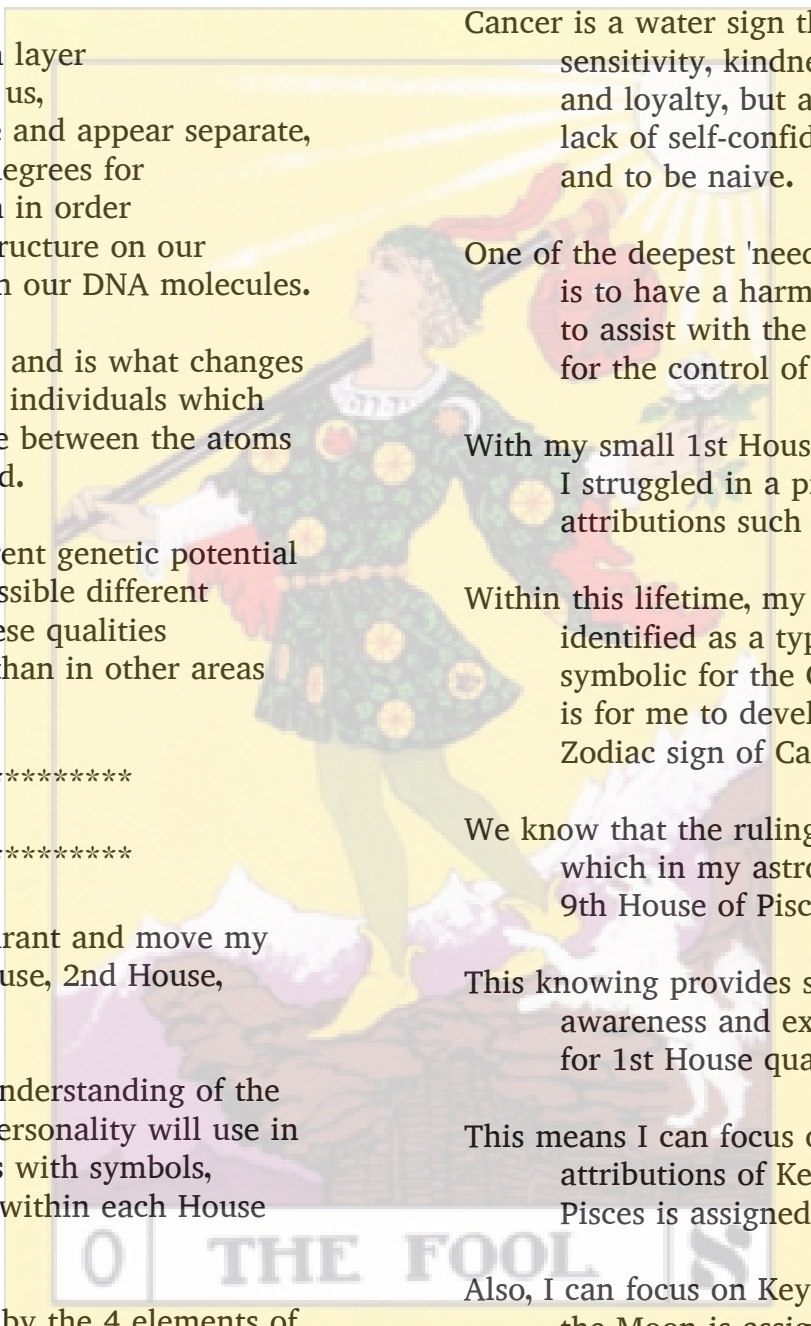
This knowing provides support of how I can achieve the awareness and expansion of my pre-birth 'need' for 1st House qualities.

This means I can focus on the Tarot symbols and attributions of Key 18, The Moon, because Pisces is assigned to this Key.

Also, I can focus on Key 2, the High Priestess, because the Moon is assigned to this Key, which reveals the symbols and attributions that will provide the guidance and support for 1st Quadrant personal development

There is also the blend of 9th House qualities which will be beneficial for my 1st House and 1st Quadrant physical and personal development.

The 9th House qualities can be summarized as higher education, travel, spirituality, and philosophy.

With my astrology chart, the important factor for us to identify with the 1st House is to understand that the accumulated experiences from birth to age 6.25 has influenced my physical development during that phase of my life, but now I have the understanding of how to speak to my subconsciousness through symbols and with my personal experience in order to expand my 1st House awareness and consciousness growth.

Within the seven stages of spiritual unfoldment, Key 4, The Emperor, is the principle of reason, which we can use Key 7, The Chariot, that is assigned the principle of speech, to channel Key 18, The Moon, as the effect of organization, and Key 2, The High Priestess, as the principle of memory.

This can be a way for us to train our mind with symbols of suggestions to our subconsciousness which is why the principles within Tarot can be most effective when exploring ourselves with Astrology.

5: 1st Quadrant: 2nd House

The 1st House was the development of the physical body, whereas the 2nd House is the development of the emotional body along with qualities that include self-sustainment, self-value, and self-worth.

From the approximate age of 6.25 to 13.5, my emotional body and consciousness growth was developed with life experiences during this particular phase in my life.

Leo is assigned to my 2nd House on the Personality layer, which means Leo qualities have colored this particular phase of development for my Personality.

I have a pre-birth 'need' for my 2nd House because of the 25 degrees of total size and this house is considered small, which means in my previous incarnation, I had difficulty with the development of self-sustainment and self-value.

The ruling planet for Leo is the Zodiac sign of the Sun, which means I can focus on the Tarot symbols and attributions of Key 17, The Star, because my Sun is located in the 7th House of Aquarius.

Also, I can focus on Key 19, the Sun, which is assigned the Zodiac sign, the Sun, and has the symbols and attributions that will provide guidance for my 2nd House emotional body development.

There is also a blend of 7th House qualities which can help aid my emotional body development, and this particular house is the relationships house that expresses the 'need' to build connections with others.

On the Foundation layer, Taurus rules the 2nd House, which is the resources house of "I Have."

The importance of hooking into the Foundation layer of the 2nd House, Taurus, does not particularly mean possessions of materialism or the value I place on objects would not be the case for my astrology chart, but can imply other qualities which can be found in the Zodiac signs on the Personality layer.

My 1st quadrant is ruled by Cancer, so the link to developing my emotional body can channel through Cancer with Leo expressions or attributions in order to develop my 1st and 2nd House pre-birth 'needs'.

My Moon in the 9th House can be a type of gateway for me to 'hook into' for my emotional body development since this is my ruling planet for the 1st quadrant.

For example, to travel, to explore spirituality, or to pursue endeavors within educational environments, and for me to create interactions with people away from my family or home environment could be difficult, but by taking action and making the choice to try and build relationships this way will assist in the development of my emotional body to a great extent.

Within the seven stages of spiritual unfoldment, Key 5, The Hierophant, is the principle of intuition, which we can use Key 8, Strength, as the agency of suggestion, to channel Key 17, The Star, as the effect of meditation, and Key 19, The Sun, as the effect of regeneration.

6: 1st Quadrant: 3rd House

The 3rd House is the final fragment of the 1st Quadrant, which is the development of the mental body.

From the approximate age of 13.5 to 22, my mental body and consciousness growth was developed with life experiences during this particular phase of my life and layered on my emotional body development and physical body development.

Virgo is assigned to my 3rd House on the Personality layer, which means Virgo qualities have colored this particular phase of development for my Personality.

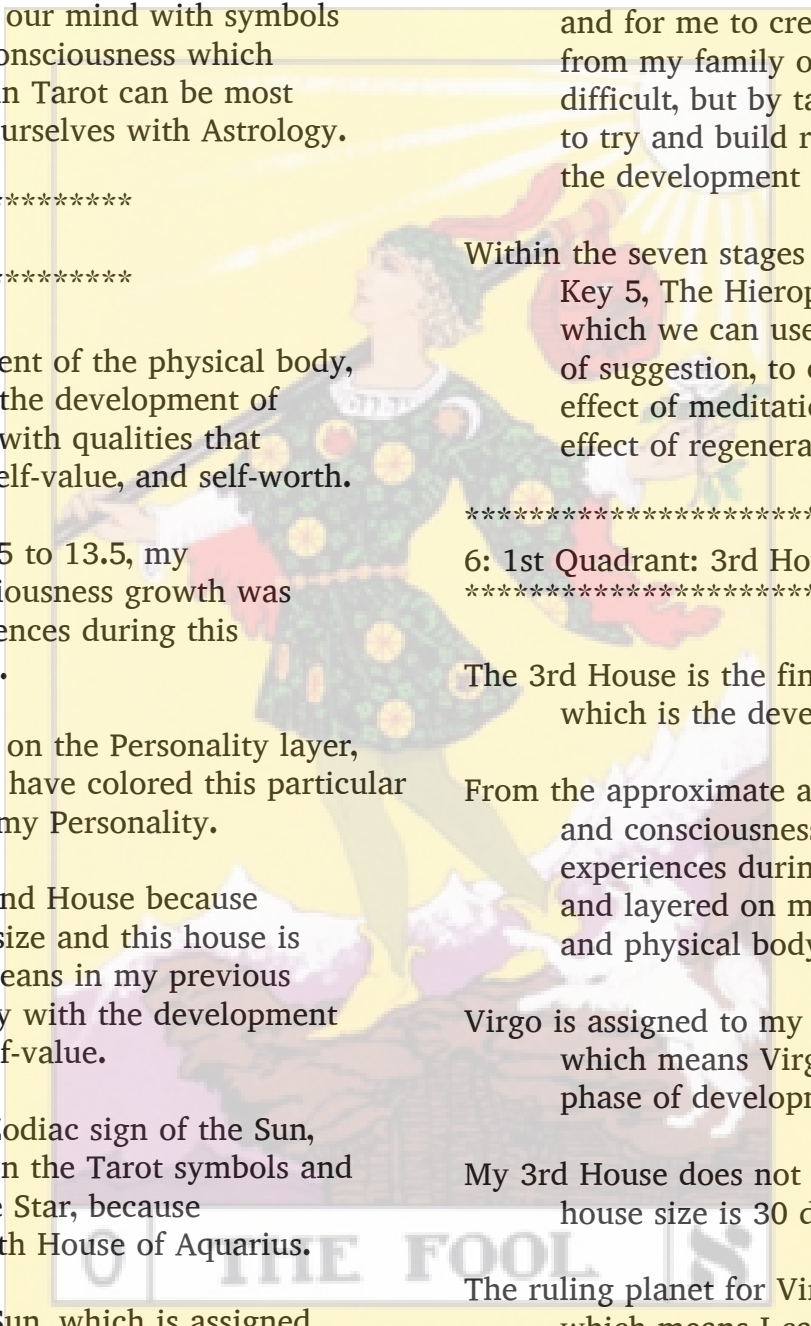
My 3rd House does not have a pre-birth 'need' because the house size is 30 degrees in size and considered balanced.

The ruling planet for Virgo is the Zodiac sign of Mercury, which means I can focus on the Tarot symbols and attributions of Key 15, The Devil, because my Mercury is located in the 7th House of Capricorn, which is assigned to Key 15.

Also, I can focus on Key 1, The Magician, which is assigned Mercury and has the meaning of self consciousness, which the symbols and attributions can provide guidance for my 3rd House mental body development.

As with my 2nd House development, the blend of 7th House qualities can help aid my mental body development of the 3rd House.

Key 9, The Hermit, is assigned Virgo, which will be the primary channel to the Foundation layer of the 3rd House, Gemini.

As with the 1st and 2nd House, I can use the 1st Quadrant ruler to assist with the building of my mental body, which means the Moon, in my 9th House, can be a type of gateway for guidance on the development of my mental body symbolized by Key 6, The Lovers.

9th House attributions can be a focal point for me to align with for my mental body, but more importantly is to know that the Moon in the 9th House, is assigned to Key 2, The High Priestess, which represents the subconsciousness and the principle of memory.

With Key 6, The Lovers, the male figure represents self consciousness, whereas the female figure represents subconsciousness, and once this union becomes harmonized, this creates a well balanced mental body.

7: 1st Quadrant: 3rd House

The 3rd House of my astrology chart has a stellium, which include the planets of Jupiter, Mars, and Saturn, so this indicates I established pre-birth 'intents' to exemplify this area of development and to use considerable amount of time in my life for this development.

My 1st quadrant have only three planets, which means I can gauge 30% of my daily energy for personal development, but all three planets are in the 3rd House.

The 3rd House has the attributions of communication, knowledge, and intellect, which for the mental body is the development of logical, analytical, and reasoning.

Although the 3rd House is balanced, I probably created these pre-birth 'intents' to allow myself to correct mistakes in thinking and attempt to not take anything personal, especially negative intentions from others.

The pre-birth 'intents' are always to assist with the pre-birth 'needs', which my mental body development will attempt to expand my 1st, 2nd, 7th, and 8th small Houses in order to create a more balanced and harmonious life.

Jupiter in my 3rd House has the 'intent' for expansion and growth which for my mental body development could have a lot of motivation provided by my Mars energy, but I reflect back on this life phase when I was about 20 years old and remember the primary reason why I joined the Marine Corps, which is symbolic for my Saturn placement.

Saturn in my 3rd House brings structure, limitations, and this energy began to invoke probabilities for me to get organized which my Jupiter and Mars definitely had young Josh disarrayed with lack of self discipline and life direction.

As for today, I still build upon my mental body and channel my 3rd House, because our life-line doesn't close any probabilities or potentialities as new growth opportunities enter our life, because our mind is a type of pattern receiver which means that any limited thoughts that occurred during my growth from age 13.5 to 22 can be identified, processed, and integrated within my consciousness.

My entire environment has changed along with almost 45 years of gathered life experiences for which I tested and trailed on myself in order to know what I do and do not want in life.

Key 10, Wheel of Fortune, is assigned the polarities of 'Wealth and Poverty', which are the extremes that external circumstances will reflect back to myself of how satisfied or unsatisfied I am with my life direction.

Key 16, The Tower, is assigned the polarities of 'Grace and Sin', which are symbolic for my choices that results in either Grace, which is 'hitting the mark' that results in correct thought and action, or Sin, which is 'missing the mark' that results in maladjustments within my life.

Key 21, The World, is assigned the polarities of 'Dominion and Slavery', which with correct interpretation of the necessity for limitation in any form of manifested existence is the secret of dominion, whereas wrong interpretation is the cause of slavery to conditions.

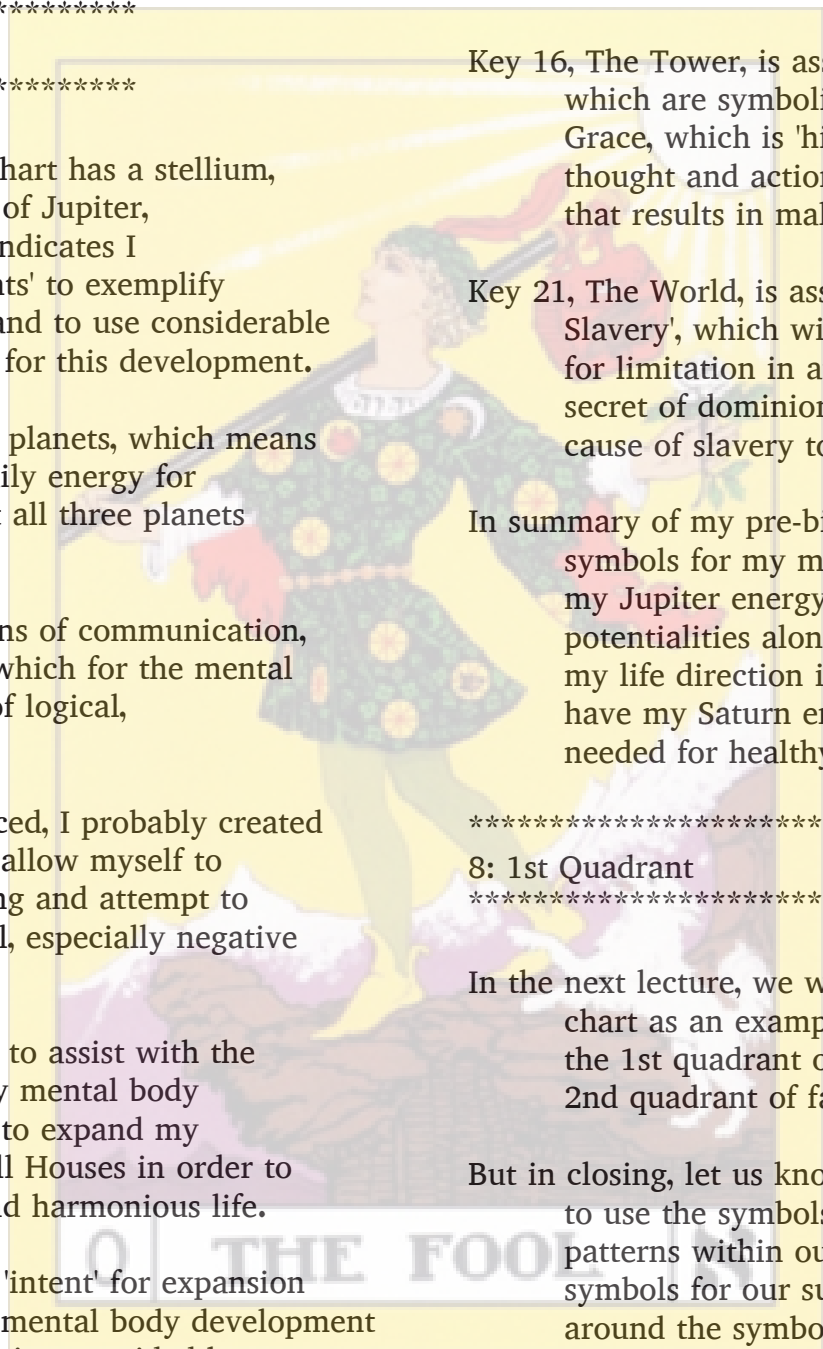
In summary of my pre-birth 'intent' and why Tarot provides symbols for my mental body development concludes that my Jupiter energy will provide big and expansive potentialities along with my Mars energy to motivate my life direction into those potentialities, but I do have my Saturn energy that provides the limitations needed for healthy and balanced mental body growth.

8: 1st Quadrant

In the next lecture, we will continue to use my astrology chart as an example of how our life-line moves from the 1st quadrant of personal development into the 2nd quadrant of family development.

But in closing, let us know that if we can train our mind to use the symbols of Tarot with Astrological patterns within our chart, then we are providing symbols for our subconsciousness to wrap meaning around the symbols so we can provide clear suggestive channels from the marriage of our self-consciousness to our subconsciousness.

When we communicate with words to each other or ourselves, there are emotional attachments to words, which can be distorted when we are impacting our subconsciousness with suggestive impressions, which is why Tarot already has all the symbols that our subconsciousness already knows.

Our subconsciousness will only reflect back what it has to work with, meaning our life experience and our personal beliefs, but when we learn the universal language of symbols with Tarot, then we can learn the principles of consciousness which will create a spiritual unfoldment that will automatically begin to assist with understandings of our growth in consciousness.

Astrology and Tarot are only gateways to the healing that we must all process from all gathered past experiences which have attached judgments of separation that stem from ignorance, but once we learn how to forgive ourselves, then accept ourselves for who we really are, then we begin to experience our Divine Remembrance and embody Truth.

This is what we all seek whether we consciously know it or not.
